REQUIREMENTS: (9 credits, total)

Students with a special interest in Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies may pursue, in the course of their regular program of studies toward an advanced degree, a special concentration in Women's & Gender Studies. According to the School of Graduate Studies of New Brunswick, students may be awarded the **Graduate Certificate in Women's & Gender Studies** upon completion of the requirements for the certificate. The requirements for the Certificate are as follows:

- * Take two Women's & Gender Studies (988) graduate courses. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- * Take one approved graduate cognate course.

Of these three courses, one must be a feminist theory course. This theory course can be any of the theory courses offered by WGSS, or it can be a course offered by another department if it has been approved by the WGSS Graduate Director. Obtain approval prior to enrolling in a course; no courses will be approved retroactively. If the theory course is from another department, then this course may satisfy the theory requirement and serve as the optional cognate course.
